The State Lottery Department is adopting amended administration regulations pursuant to Chapters 575 and 321, 2008 Acts of Assembly (http://leg1.state.va.us/cgi-bin/legp504.exe?081+ful+CHAP0575 and http://leg1.state.va.us/cgibin/legp504.exe?081+ful+CHAP0321).

Section 58.1-4007 states The Board shall have the power to adopt regulations governing the establishment and operation of a lottery. The regulations governing the establishment and operation of the lottery shall be promulgated by the Board after consultation with the Director. Such regulations shall be in accordance with the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.).

It has been over nine (9) years since this chapter has been reviewed for changes and/or updates. In an effort to become more customer focused, the Agency is pursuing expanding our presence to the citizens of the Commonwealth and ensuring the integrity of our licensed retailers.

Added more flexibility for our licensed retailers to receive or maintain bonding requirements. Added language to define the expected ethical requirements of the Department's licensed retailers.
