This regulation details what errors or omissions on the Envelope B required by Va. Code § 24.2-706 must render an absentee ballot invalid. It represents the culmination of a process to develop regulatory guidance that began in 2010. After receiving more than 500 public comments on a draft regulation published September 12, 2011, the State Board of Elections at its meeting on October 13, 2011, voted to defer action to allow consideration of further changes to the regulations based on the comment received. A new draft was presented to the Board at its meeting on January 23, 2012, and unanimously approved. This regulation replaces an earlier one adopted in late 2010 that did not become effective and was withdrawn before preclearance. Upon preclearance, this regulation will replace Board policy 2008-006, Substantial Compliance currently in effect.
