**Subject:** Letter of Assurance for Amendments to Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators Regulations

I have reviewed the amendments to the Board for Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators's Regulations that were posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall internet site on November 15, 2005. In my view, as counsel to the Board for Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators, the Board may promulgate these regulations pursuant to § 54.1-201(5) of the *Code of Virginia*. The proposed amendments do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
