RE: 18 VAC 60-20-10 et seq. Regulations Governing Dental Practice

Dear Ms. Reen:

You have asked whether the proposed changes to the above-cited regulations are exempt from the operation of Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act.

The proposed amendments to sections 20, 30, 90, and 91 are necessary to conform regulations for temporary and faculty licenses to Chapters 20 and 116 of the 2012 Acts of the Assembly. Proposed amendments to section 220 are necessary to conform regulations for dental hygienists to Chapter 102 of the 2012 Acts of the Assembly.

Therefore, the changes conform regulations to the Code and are exempt in accordance with § 2.2-4006 A 4, which provides an exemption for regulations: "Necessary to conform to changes in Virginia statutory law or the appropriation act where no agency discretion is involved."

Having satisfied all legal requirements, you may proceed to take the necessary steps to promulgate this exempt regulation with the Registrar of Regulations.
