Regulations of the Board of Nursing need to be amended for consistency with the Code of Virginia. In Chapter 762 of the 2003 Acts of the Assembly, the minimum period for reinstatement of a license after revocation was set at three years.

§ 54.1-2408.2. Three-year minimum period for reinstatement after revocation.

When the certificate, registration or license of any person certified, registered or licensed by one of the health regulatory boards has been revoked, the board may, after three years and upon the payment of a fee prescribed by the Board, consider an application for reinstatement of a certificate, registration or license in the same manner as the original certificates, registrations or licenses are granted. The reinstatement of a certificate, registration or license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members at a meeting. In the discretion of the board, such reinstatement may be granted without further examination.

Currently, regulations of the Board in section 230 D state that a nurse cannot reapply after revocation for <u>two</u> years. For consistency with the Code, the rule should state that a nurse cannot reapply for <u>three</u> years after revocation.

On May 17, 2005, the Board of Nursing adopted an exempt action to amend Section 230 for consistency with § <u>54.1-2408.2</u> of the Code of Virginia. Although required to comply with the Virginia Register Act, the agency is exempt from provisions of the Administrative Process Act for the implementation of these regulations pursuant to § 2.2-4006 A 4, which grants an exemption if the action is: "Necessary to conform to changes in Virginia statutory law or the appropriation act where no agency discretion is involved."
