PART I.

GENERAL PROVISIONS.

18 VAC 90-50-30. Fees.

A. Fees listed in this section shall be payable to the Treasurer of Virginia and shall not be refunded unless otherwise provided.

PART III.

RENEWAL AND REINSTATEMENT.

18 VAC 90-50-80. Reinstatement of lapsed certificates.

- A. A massage therapist whose certificate has lapsed may reinstate his certification within one renewal period by payment of the current renewal fee and the late renewal fee.
- A. B. A massage therapist whose certificate has lapsed <u>for more than one renewal period</u> shall file a reinstatement application and pay the current renewal fee and the reinstatement fee.
- C. A massage therapist whose certificate has suspended or revoked may apply for reinstatement by filing a reinstatement application and paying the fee for reinstatement after suspension or revocation.
- <u>B.D.</u> The board may require evidence that the massage therapist is prepared to resume practice in a competent manner.
