Current regulations of the Board of Pharmacy in Chapter 20 provide an exclusion for the *Division of Forensic Science within the Department of Criminal Justice Services* from requirements to inventory quantities of controlled substances used to conduct chemical analyses and controlled substances received for analyses as evidentiary material as provided in §54.1-3404 G of the Code of Virginia.

In Chapters 868 and 881 of the 2005 Acts of the Assembly, the Department of Forensic Science was created, replacing the former Division of Forensic Science. Therefore, an amendment to correct the name of the agency consistent with § 9.1-1100 of the Code of Virginia was adopted under an exempt action to conform regulations to the statute.

Statement of final agency action

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On September 27, 2006, the Board of Pharmacy adopted an exempt action to amend section 720 to conform to § 9.1-1100 of the Code of Virginia. Although required to comply with the Virginia Register Act, the agency is exempt from provisions of the Administrative Process Act for the implementation of these regulations pursuant to § 2.2-4006 A 4, which grants an exemption if the action is: "Necessary to conform to changes in Virginia statutory law or the appropriation act where no agency discretion is involved."
