Section 3.1-926 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, gives the Board of Agriculture and Consumer Services discretionary authority to adopt regulations pertaining to the method of sale of commodities, standards of net weight, measure or count, standards of fill for commodities in package form, and exemptions.

The Department published its notice in The Virginia Register of Regulations on February 12, 2001 advertising the opportunity to comment on this regulation pursuant to Executive Order Number Twenty-five (98). The agency did not receive any comments from the public regarding this regulation in response to this notice. An informal advisory group was not formed for the purpose of assisting with this periodic review.

Amendments to the Virginia Weights and Measures Law by the 1993 Session of the General Assembly have rendered the regulation ineffective. The 1993 amendments included the adoption, by reference, of sections of the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), Handbook 130. The adopted sections of Handbook 130 replaced and eliminated the need for regulations addressing labeling and method of sale. All remaining provisions contained in 2 VAC 5-340 are obsolete or are adequately addressed by other state laws or regulations

Alternatives
