HB1598 (2009) is a comprehensive amendment of Article 1.1 of Chapter 4 of Title 32.1 of the Code of Virginia related to the Certificate of Public Need (COPN) program. The amendments to the Code included, but were not limited to: (i) replacing the 21 considerations used in making a determination of need with eight modified and abbreviated considerations; (ii) adding beds for psychiatric or substance abuse treatment services and the establishment of new psychiatric or substance abuse treatment services to the Request for Applications (RFA) process currently used for distributing nursing facility beds; (iii) extending the expedited review process to certain capital expenditure projects; and (iv) modifying the requirements of the annual report. Therefore, applicable sections of 12VAC5-220 must be amended to conform to the law. In addition, a technical correction to 12VAC5-220-105 corrects a misquoted statutory citation.
