VDH administers the Nursing Scholarship program, which provides annual nursing scholarships for students enrolled part-time and/or full-time in undergraduate and graduate nursing programs. Selected recipients agree to engage in full-time nursing practice in the Commonwealth. Sections 23-35.9 through 23-35.13 of the *Code of Virginia* authorize an Advisory Committee, appointed by the State Board of Health (board), to select scholarship recipients.

The amendments being proposed for this regulation are technical in nature and reflect changes regarding the name of the office that administers this program, the address where applicants should send their applications and application processes and procedures.

The board originally adopted these regulations in order to implement §§ 23-35.9 through 23-35.13 and as authorized by §§ 32.1-122.6:01 and 54.1-3011.2 of the *Code of Virginia*. Sections 23-35.9 and 32.1-122.6:01 of the *Code* authorize the Board to award annual scholarships for students enrolled in undergraduate and graduate nursing programs in Virginia.

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Need

The intent of the nursing scholarship program is to increase the number of qualified nurses serving the Commonwealth. Well over 100 future nurses receive these scholarships annually, and most recipients will graduate and become licensed practitioners serving in Virginia. The amendments proposed for this regulation are pertinent so that prospective nursing scholarship applicants are aware of which office administers this program, where to send their applications and are aware of the most current application processes and procedures.

Substance

- 1. All areas in the regulation that mention the name, "Office of Public Health Nursing" will change to the "Virginia Department of Health, Division of Primary Care and Rural Health."
- 2. The address of the Office of Public Health Nursing will be removed.
- 3. 12 VAC 5-510-60 will be updated to reflect actual current procedures regarding "How to Apply." Applications will no longer be available from the Deans/Directors Offices at the nursing programs; rather, an online application is made available to prospective students.

Alternatives

VDH sees no viable alternative for the proposed regulatory action. The action is necessary to assure consistency with the name of the office that administers the regulations. In addition, an online application process is being implemented to reduce waste and streamline the application and review process.
