**Subject:** Letter of Assurance for Amendments to 1VAC45-10: Regulations Governing

Disclosure of Civil Investigative Demand Material.

I have reviewed the Office of the Attorney General's proposed amendments to the Regulations Governing Disclosure of CID (Civil Investigative Demand) Material, 1 VAC 45-10-10 *et seq.*, that were posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall Internet site on July 26, 2011. In my view, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to the Virginia Antitrust Act, § 59.1-9.1 *et seq.* of the *Code of Virginia*. The regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
