12 VAC 30-40-345. Eligibility under Section 1931 of the Act.

The State covers low-income families and children under Section 1931 of the *Act:* AFDC children age 18 who are full-time students in a secondary school or in the equivalent level of vocational or technical training. In determining eligibility for Medicaid, the agency uses the AFDC standards and methodologies in effect as of July 16, 1996, without modification, for individuals who do not receive TANF benefits.

The agency continues to apply the following waivers of provisions of Part A of title IV in effect as of July 16, 1996, or submitted prior to August 22, 1996, and approved by the Secretary on or before July 1, 1997. For individuals who receive TANF benefits and meet the requirements of Virginia's § 1115 waiver for the Virginia Independence Program (VIP), the agency continues to apply the following waivers of provisions of Part A of Title IV in effect as of July 16, 1996, or submitted prior to August 22, 1996, and approved by the Secretary on or before July 1, 1997.
