**SUBJECT:** Regulations Relating to the Issuance of Nonresident

Concealed Handgun Carry Permits – 19 VAC 30-

190-10 and 19 VAC 30-190-50

In response to a request from the Department of State Police, I have reviewed the regulations, 19 VAC 30-190-10 and 19 VAC 30-190-50, relating to the issuance of nonresident concealed handgun carry permits. Virginia Code § 18.2-308.06(E) requires the Superintendent of State Police to promulgate regulations, pursuant to the Administrative Process Act, for the implementation of an application process for obtaining a nonresident concealed handgun permit.

Upon review of the aforesaid regulations, I find the proposed regulations to be constitutional, consistent with the statutory authority granted by Virginia Code § 18.2-308.06(E) of the Code of Virginia, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions. I am of the opinion that the regulations are exempted from Administrative Process Act pursuant to Virginia Code § 2.2-4006(A)(3), as the regulations consist only of changes in style or form or corrections of technical errors
