**SUBJECT:** Motor Vehicle Safety Inspection Rules and Regulations; 19 VAC 30-70-2, et seq.

In response to a request from the Department of State Police, I have reviewed the proposed amendments to the regulations set forth in 19 VAC 30-70-2, *et seq.*, relating to motor vehicle safety inspection rules and regulations. Upon review of the aforesaid amendments, I find them to be constitutional, consistent with the statutory authority conferred by § 46.2-1165 of the Code of Virginia, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions. As expressed in an earlier memorandum, these changes to the regulations are made pursuant to a customary police function of the Department and is therefore exempted from the requirements of the Administrative Process Act, pursuant to § 2.2-4002(B)(6).
