AIRPORT ACCESS FUNDING PROGRAM

CHAPTER 450.

<u>24 VAC 30-450-10</u>. Introduction.

The airport access road fund program is used to provide access to publicly owned licensed, public-use airports.

24 VAC 30-450-20. Policy.

The Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB), in cooperation with the Department of Aviation, shall administer the funds for the construction of access routes to publicly owned licensed, public-use airports.

24 VAC 30-450-30. Limitations.

Airport access funding shall not be used for the acquisition of rights of way or adjustment of utilities.

24 VAC 30-450-40. Funding criteria and exceptions.

<u>A.</u> Not more than $$250,000 \\ $300,000$ annually shall be allocated to serve any one airport. Prior to the allocation, the governing body of the county, city, or town must, by resolution, request the access funds. The governing body must commit for the right-of-way and utility adjustment as needed.

B. If funding is supplemented by money other than from highway funds, additional funding may be approved on a dollar-by-dollar matching basis. This provision applies only if the total estimated cost of eligible items for the improvements exceeds \$300,000. This additional funding shall not exceed \$150,000.
