**Subject:** Letter of Assurance for Amendments to Manufactured Home Licensing and Transaction

**Recovery Fund Regulations** 

I have reviewed the Manufactured Housing Board's proposed amendments to the Manufactured Home Licensing and Transaction Recovery Fund Regulations, 13 VAC 6-20-10 *et seq.*, that were posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall Internet site on January 19, 2010. In my view, as counsel to the Manufactured Housing Board, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to §§ 36 – 85.18 of the *Code of Virginia*. The regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
