The Virginia Marine Resources Commission (VMRC) is repealing Chapter 4VAC20-850-10 et seq., "Expansion of the Jail Island Clean Cull Area" to increase regulatory efficiency by reducing regulatory requirements.

## **Mandate and Impetus**

[Mandate] VMRC is authorized by § 28.2-201 of the Code of Virginia to promulgate regulations and guidelines necessary to carry out the provisions of Title 28.2, including marine fisheries regulations.

[Impetus] VMRC Commission Board currently establishes by regulation, Chapter 4VAC20-720-10 et seq., "Pertaining to Restrictions on Oyster Harvest", the areas of public oyster harvest, public oyster harvest seasons and oyster resource conservation measures if they wish these to be different from those which are established by §28.2-506 of The Code of Virginia. This regulation supersedes other regulations, including Chapter 850 that in the past had addressed individual harvest areas. As such, there is no need for this regulation while Chapter 4VAC20-720-10 et seq., is in effect.
