During the 2023 session, the General Assembly adopted House Bill 1418, which directs the board to accept the PAREA Program as fulfilling certain amounts of Board's experience requirements. Practical Applications of Real Estate Appraisal (PAREA) is a simulated appraisal training program that can be done entirely in a virtual environment. It is endorsed by the Appraisal Foundation, which is authorized by the United States Congress to provide guidance to the states regarding the practice of real estate appraisal. It appears the first program was set to launch in September of 2023, but it is not clear that any have actually started. This exempt action will implement the statutory requirement for the Board to accept PAREA training.

This action is exempt from the Administrative Process Act under § 2.2-4006(A)(4)(a) of the Code of Virginia, which states, in part:

A. The following agency actions otherwise subject to this chapter and § 2.2-4103 of the Virginia Register Act shall be exempted from the operation of this article:

- 4. Regulations that are:
- a. Necessary to conform to changes in Virginia statutory law or the appropriation act where no agency discretion is involved.

In March 2023, the Governor approved Chapter 106 (HB 1418) of the 2023 Acts of Assembly, adopted PAREA as satisfying the Board's experience requirements. The amendments became effective on July 1, 2023.
