**Subject:** Letter of Assurance for Proposed Regulations - Amendments to the Regulations Governing

Certified Lead Contractors Notification, Lead Project Permits and Permit Fees - 16VAC25-35

I have reviewed the Department of Labor and Industry's and Safety and Health Codes Board's proposed Amendments referenced above to the Regulations Governing Certified Lead Contractors Notification, Lead Project Permits and Permit Fees that were posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall on June 18, 2014. In my view, as counsel to the Department of Labor and Industry and the Safety and Health Codes Board, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to Title 40.1 of the Code of Virginia. The regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
