In my view, as counsel to the Department of Labor and Industry, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to Title 40.1 of the Code of Virginia. Further, I certify that the proposed changes are exempt from the Administrative Process Act under <u>Code of Virginia</u> § 2.2-4006(A)(4)(c) as the changes are necessary to meet the requirements of federal law or regulations and they do not materially differ from those required by federal law or regulation.
