Re: Repeal of Rules Governing Proposed Contractual Agreements with Professional Personnel (8 VAC 20-430-10)

Dear Dr. DeMary:

You ask whether the Virginia Board of Education possesses the requisite statutory authority to repeal the above Rules Governing Contractual Agreements with Professional Personnel, 8 VAC 20-430-10.

Section 22.1-16 vests the Board of Education with the authority to promulgate such regulations as may be necessary to carry out its powers and duties and the provisions of Title 22.1. In addition, § 22.1-302 directs the Board to prescribe the forms of contracts for teachers, including supplemental contracts for coaching and extracurricular activities. In the time since the adoption of the above-referenced regulations, the Board has adopted separate Regulations Governing the Employment of Professional Personnel, 8 VAC 20-440-10, *et seq*. At the time of this more recent adoption, the older regulations should have been repealed; at a minimum, they are unnecessary. Repeal of these regulations is an appropriate and advisable course of action.
