Regulations Governing Pupil Rights and Hearings

8VAC 20-480

8VAC 20-480-10. Hearing to challenge information in pupil record.

A. Requests for hearings shall be sent to principals of the school or district office administrators as appropriate.

B. Principals or administrators shall set a time and place for the hearing and shall notify the person making the request, in writing, of the time and place. The hearing shall be set within 45 days of receipt of the request.

C. At the hearing, the principals or administrators shall have present the persons who have entered the information in question. The parent, legal guardian, or student who requested the hearing shall have the right to question those persons and shall be able to show evidence that would correct inaccurate, misleading, or otherwise inappropriate information. Such evidence shall become a permanent part of the student's records.
