Re: Regulations Governing Local School Board and School Divisions (8 VAC 20-720-10 et seq.)

Dear Dr. Wright:

You ask whether the Board of Education possesses the requisite authority to amend the above-referenced regulations by adding a section relating to fees and charges.

Section 22.1-16 vests the Board of Education with the authority to promulgate such regulations as may be necessary to carry out its powers and duties and the provisions of Title 22.1. In addition, the General Assembly has directed that local school boards may not levy any fees or charges on a pupil except as provided by Title 22.1 or as permitted by regulation of the Board. Accordingly, it is my view that the Board possesses the requisite authority to adopt and amend the above-referenced regulations.
