- **SUBJECT:** Comprehensive Revision of the Licensure Regulations for School Personnel Proposed Regulation 8 VAC 20-23-10, *et seq.*, and Repeal of 8 VAC 20-22-10, *et seq.*

I have reviewed the proposed regulation and corresponding repeal as emailed to me on April 17, 2014 to determine if it exceeds the statutory authority of the State Board of Education (Board).

Pursuant to Virginia Code § 22.1-16, the Board has authority to promulgate regulations to carry out its statutory powers and duties. Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 22.1-298.1 and 22.1-299, the Board has specific authority to promulgate this regulation.

It is this Office's view that the State Board of Education has the authority to promulgate this regulation, subject to compliance with the provisions of Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act and Executive Order 14 (2010), and has not exceeded that authority.
