- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

- DISCUSSION:** Dr. West-Johnson appeared before the Committee in person in accordance with a Notice of the Board dated February 26, 2014. Dr. West-Johnson was represented by Meredith Brebner, Esquire and Gerald Canaan, Esquire.
- The Committee fully discussed the allegations in the Notice with Dr. West-Johnson.
- CLOSED SESSION:** Upon a motion by Dr. Tuck, and duly seconded by Ms. Kleine, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. West-Johnson. Additionally, he moved that Dr. Harp and Ms. Wood attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.
- RECONVENE:** Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open session and announced its decision.

DECISION:

Upon a motion by Ms. Kleine, and duly seconded by Dr. Tuck, the Committee made certain findings of fact and conclusions of law and voted to place Dr. West-Johnson's license on indefinite probation and subject her license to certain terms and conditions.

VOTE:

The vote was unanimous.

ADJOURNMENT:

The Committee adjourned at 1:52 p.m.

A formal hearing will be scheduled for a future date for a final determination.

As provided by law this decision shall become a Final Order thirty (30) days after service of such Order on Dr. West-Johnson, unless a written request to the Board for a formal hearing on the allegations made against her is received from Dr. West-Johnson, within such time. If service of the Order is made by mail three (3) additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of the Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.
