

**THE VIRGINIA BOARD OF SOCIAL WORK
CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE MEETING**

MINUTES

Friday, July 19, 2013

The Credentials Committee of the Virginia Board of Social Work convened at 8:35 a.m. on Friday, July 19, 2013 at the Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Richmond, Virginia. Jennifer Blosser called the meeting to order.

CALL TO ORDER:

Ms. Blosser welcomed the Committee members and called the meeting to order.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The minutes from the April 19, 2013 Credentials Committee meeting were approved as written.

CLOSED SESSION:

Mr. Mayer moved that the Committee convene in Closed Meeting pursuant to Section 2.2-3711(4) in accordance with Section 2.2-3704(A) and 54.1-108 of the Code of Virginia to discuss applications for licensure. He moved that Sarah Georgen and Patricia Larimer attend the Closed Meeting because their presence in the Closed Meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

OPEN SESSION:

Mr. Mayer moved that pursuant to Section 2.2-3712 of the Code of Virginia that the Committee heard, discussed or considered only those public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Freedom of Information Act and only such public business matters as identified in her motion by which the closed meeting was convened.

DISCUSSION:

The Committee considered 15 licensure and supervision requests. Files are referred by the Credentials Reviewer to the Committee for evaluation when the Reviewer is unable to render a

decision. The files sent to the Committee represent a small percentage of the applications that are processed each quarter.

DECISION:

The Credentials Committee made the following determinations:

1. Denied three (3) applications due to education concerns;
2. Denied one (1) application due to education, documentation and supervision concerns;
3. Denied one (1) application due to education, supervision and possible dual relationship;
4. Denied three (3) applications due to supervision concerns;
5. Denied one (1) application due to documentation and supervision concerns;
6. Denied one (1) application due to out-of-state licensure not in good standing;
7. Approved one (1) application due to ethical and supervision concerns;
8. Approved four (4) applications due to conviction concerns.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Credentials Committee, the meeting adjourned at 9:30 a.m.
