



VOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: 02-216

ISSUED: July 15, 1992

SUBJECT: Electrical Safety-Related Work Practices--Inspection Procedures and Interpretive Guidelines

A. <u>Purpose</u>.

This Directive establishes policies and provides interpretive guidelines to ensure uniform enforcement of the Standard for Electrical Safety-Related Work Practices, §§1910.331 through 1910.335.

B. <u>Scope</u>.

This Directive applies to all VOSH personnel and specifically to Occupational Safety Enforcement and On-site Consultation personnel.

C. <u>Reference</u>.

OSHA Instruction STD 1-16.7 (July 1, 1991).

D. <u>Cancellation</u>.

E. <u>Action</u>.

The Assistant Commissioner, Directors and Supervisors shall assure that the policies and procedures established in this directive are adhered to in conducting inspections under the standard on electrical safety-related work practices.

I. <u>Summary</u>.

The attached directive provides inspection procedures and interpretative guidelines for conducting inspections involving electrical safety-related work practices. The inspection procedures in this directive shall be integrated with those of the Lockout/Tagout Standard, §1910.147, where it is possible to do so.
