**SUBJECT:** Regulations for Regulations Relating to Standards and Specifications for Back-Up

Audible Alarm Signals for certain vehicles used primarily for highway repair and

maintenance -19 VAC 30-140, et. seq.

In response to a request from the Virginia State Police, I have examined the current regulations which are up for periodic review, 19 VAC 30 - 140 et seq., relating to standards and specifications for back-up audible alarm signals for certain vehicles used primarily for highway repair and maintenance .

Virginia Code § 46.2-1175.1 provides that the Virginia State Police to shall approve devices which automatically emits an audible alarm signal when the vehicle is operated in reverse gear. Upon review of the aforesaid regulations, I find the regulations to be constitutional, consistent with the statutory authority granted by Virginia Code § 46.2-915.1, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions.
