The purpose of the regulation is to protect waters of the Chesapeake Bay from discharges of oil and gas resulting from well drilling and related production and transportation activities. Virginia Code §62.1-195.1 requires the Department of Environmental Quality, in accordance with the Administrative Process Act, to develop criteria and procedures to assure the orderly preparation and evaluation of environmental impact assessments for oil or gas well drilling activities proposed to be conducted in Tidewater, Virginia. There is no applicable federal mandate.

During the public comment period, DEQ received one comment from the Department of Conservation and Recreation. In general, DCR requested that the regulations include the Department and other agencies on the mailing list for receiving notification of environmental impact assessments, specific plans for development and other related review material. DCR's requests are already built into the DEQ's review process. The review of oil and gas drilling projects will be conducted in accordance with the Environmental Impact Review Procedure manual that has been developed pursuant to Virginia code § 10.1-1188 et.seq.

The goals of this regulation are to (1) protect public health and/or welfare with the least possible costs and intrusiveness to the citizens and businesses of the Commonwealth and (2) establish criteria and procedures for preparing and evaluating environmental impact assessments for oil or gas well drilling operations and related production and transportation activities proposed to occur in Tidewater Virginia to protect waters of the Chesapeake Bay from discharges of oil and gas resulting from the operations/activities.

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The regulation is effective in meeting its goals and is essential to protect the health, safety or welfare of citizens by ensuring that possible environmental impacts from an oil or gas well drilling operation are considered so that appropriate safeguards can be provided for the Commonwealth's natural resources.

The regulation was subjected to extensive review by a wide range of reviewers (state and local government officials and the general public), prior to final approval. Changes were incorporated to improve the clarity and simplicity of the regulation.

Alternatives

The regulation is mandated by statute. The Department considered using a checklist to be filled out by the applicant instead of a narrative document. However, this alternative was rejected. A checklist would not provide an applicant with sufficient information to prepare an assessment or the State to review an assessment, nor was a checklist deemed appropriate as the foundation of the regulation itself.

Recommendation
