**Other Board
Business**

Eric Olson briefed the Board bringing them up to date regarding the results of this past General Assembly session. Specifically, they were informed that there would be another person assigned to the Board, and elevator mechanic/contractor, which would bring the total number of members to 14. The Board was also made aware that one of their own would be requested to serve, in addition to their contractor duties, on the ALHI Board (Asbestos, Lead and Home Inspection). Another legislative mandate that was brought before the Board, involved the “stakeholder” meeting(s) that would assist the General Assembly in determining whether or not residential elevator mechanics should be regulated and, if so, the extent of that regulation. The Board provided staff

with instruction on how to put the panel together, inclusive of three Board members, Tomlin, Hart and Sumpter; and conduct this non-study.

Other issues regarding geothermal well drillers, the authority for Building Officials to issue citations to unlicensed contractors and even voice stress analyzers were discussed.

After discussion, Ms. Wood offered a motion seconded by Mr. Sumpter to receive the update from Mr. Olson and to have staff to proceed with the areas identified. The motion passed by unanimous vote. Other Education-Related Items*

Jill Richardson, Licensing and Education Administrator, advised the Committee that Board staff has received an increased number of incomplete Tradesmen continuing education applications. The courses have been incomplete in that they are not comprehensive of all code updates. The Committee reiterated and recommended that the syllabus for a Tradesmen continuing education course must be all encompassing and comprehensive of the respective code changes.

An education audit report was presented to the Committee. The staff audit team consisted of Eric Olson, Adrienne Mayo, and Jill Richardson. This report provided February 18, 2009 findings for four continuing education courses coordinated by the Water Well Association of Virginia, an approved provider.

New Business*

Eric Olson, Executive Director for the Board for Contractors addressed the Committee by providing legislative updates for the 2009 session of the General Assembly. In response, the Committee recommends to convene a ten member panel to review certified elevator mechanics legislation and to submit a report to the General Assembly by November 8, 2009.

Licensing entry requirements for elevator mechanics were presented to the Committee for review by Adrienne Mayo. The Committee determined that the entry requirements for Florida and Georgia were substantially equivalent to Virginia’s education and experience requirements. The Committee recommended that individuals licensed in Florida and Georgia other than by reciprocity may qualify by substantial equivalency to take Virginia’s Elevator Mechanics examination.

After discussion a motion was made by **Ms. Wood** and seconded by **Mr. Hart** to approve the Continuing Education recommendations. The motion passed by unanimous vote. Members voting “yes” were: **Kirby, Rusher, Redifer, Smith, Hart, Tomlin, Sumpter, Modisett, Walton, Williams and Wood.**
