Fenton stated that when a towing company signs a contract with another entity to provide service in a parking lot, that contract is considered the first signature. When a vehicle is reported for tow by the property owner, at the time the tower comes out to the property, than he/she needs to get the second signature.

Ad Hoc Committee Discussion:

There were various discussions on complaints, contracts, selling of property, pamphlets, and information's on city ordinances from the Committee and the public.
