Mr. Crooks moved the adoption of the agenda prepared by staff, Adopt Agenda which was seconded by Dr. Degen and carried by a unanimous aye vote.

Mr. Dick briefed the Committee members on the role of the Role of Board Board in developing regulation provisions establishing a regulatory program for the three new professions.

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Mr. Dick explained that HB 3134 and SB 1270 mandated that Roles of DPOR and DPOR and VDH work together to establish the new regulatory VDH One of the professions, Authorized Onsite Soil Evaluator, is currently regulated by VDH and must transfer smoothly to DPOR to prevent any disruption in the availability of qualified practitioners to the public. Alternative Onsite Sewage System Installers and Alternative Onsite Sewage System Operators are not currently regulated. All three must be properly qualified to perform tasks in compliance with VDH regulations, thus the importance of VDH involvement throughout the process. Mr. Dick explained that the challenge ahead of the Committee Challenge and the Board is to develop draft regulations to set appropriate education, experience, examination, and performance/discipline standards for the newly-regulated professions.

Mr. Dick explained that any examination to be used to determine **Examination** entry level competence for any license must be developed by a vendor capable of employing psychometric principles to develop

Mr. Dick noted the research performed by Anna Badgley, Working Documents Administrative Assistant, into the requirements of other jurisdictions to become licensed as onsite sewage system professionals and the documents generated by that research that were in front of the Board for their review.

a valid and defensible examination or examinations.

The Committee proceeded to discuss possible regulation provisions for licensed onsite soil evaluators based on the Virginia Department of Health regulations and the regulations of the states of North Carolina, Kentucky and Minnesota, which were included in a single document for ease of reference.
