Proposed General Regulations	The Committee re-reviewed comments regarding the proposed regulations. Discussion centered on the definition of branch and specifically, 18 VAC 20-170 (E) and (F). With a properly seconded motion by Mr. Jenkins, the Committee voted to recommend the following to the Board: Redefine "Branch or Chapel" to mean a funeral service establishment which is affiliated with a licensed main establishment and conforms with the requirements of 54.1-2811 of the Code of Virginia; Delete proposed regulations 18 VAC 65-20-170 (E) and (F). Add Section E to read, "The main establishment shall specify the branch or chapel on the application for licensure."

## Virginia Board of Funeral Directors and Embalmers Legislative/Regulatory Committee Meeting April 22, 2003

The Committee examined 18 VAC 65-20-570 and discussed OSHA requirements for storing chemical on floors in the preparation room. The committee asked staff to research the current OSHA procedures and report at the June 4, 2003 board meeting.

**LEGISLATIVE PROPOSALS FOR 2004:** The Committee approved FDE- 2, 3 and 4 for submission to the Board. The Committee asked the Executive Director to seek an AG opinion on the felony statutes of 54.1-2806 and 54.1-2813 and their applicable usage in disciplinary cases. The Committee requested the staff to redraft FDE- 4 and submit to Board at the June 4, 2003 meeting.
