CLOSED SESSION:	Upon a motion by Linda Seeman and duly seconded by John Brendel, the Board voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to $\S$ 2.2-3711(A)(27) of the Code of Virginia for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Cynthia Delaney. Additionally, she moved that Mr. Casway, Ms. Brown, Ms. Larimer, and Ms. Harris attend the closed meeting, because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Board in its deliberations.
