Discussion: The Board received evidence and sworn testimony regarding the

allegations contained in the Notice.

Closed Session: Upon a motion by Ms. Stransky, and duly seconded by Dr. Tinsley, the Board

voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711(A)(27) of the Code of Virginia for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter. Additionally, she moved that James Rutkowski, Jaime Hoyle, and Jennifer Lang attend the closed meeting because their presence was deemed

necessary and would aid the Board in its deliberation.

Reconvene: Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session

met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Board reconvened in open

session and announced its decision.

Decision and Vote: Ms. Hunt moved that the Board of Counseling revoke the QMHP-A and

QMHP-C registrations of Brian Artis. The basis for this decision will be set forth in a final Board Order which will be sent to Mr. Artis at the address of record. The motion was seconded by Dr. Yancey and carried unanimously.

Adjournment: The Board adjourned at 11:45 a.m.

The decision shall be effective upon the entry by the Board of a written Order stating the findings, conclusions and decisions of this formal hearing panel.
