# APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF OCTOBER 3, 2006

Patricia Cooper moved to approve the minutes dated October 3, 2006. The motion was seconded and carried.

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#### ADOPTION OF AGENDA

## PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS

Alexander Macaulay, Virginia Occupational Therapy Association, stated that he would like to comment on agenda items during the discussion by the Advisory Board; Mr. Dr. Loveland agreed to this approach.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### **#1. OT Audit - 2004**

Ola Powers discussed the results of the first occupational therapy audit for the 2004 renewal. She also discussed the 2006 audit that consisted of 26 participants resulting in 100% compliance. Following a thorough discussion, the advisory board voted to issue Confidential Consent Agreements to those licensees who were found noncompliant or who did not respond.

# #2. Review of the November 7, 2006 Subcommittee of the Advisory Board Minutes

Ms. Yeatts reviewed the November 7, 2006 Subcommittee of the Advisory Board minutes. No actions were taken.

# #3. Supervision of fieldwork students for Type II CE credit

Jeffrey Loveland discussed developing a policy for licensees to get Type II CE credits for supervising students. He also reviewed how the NBCOT currently defines Type II CE credits. After lengthy discussion, it was suggested that there be a breakdown of the Type II CE credits provided on the Department of Health Professions website as a part of the frequently asked questions and answers. After discussion, the Advisory Board agreed to move forward.

## #4. Discussion of possible language update to regulations regarding COTA's

There was discussion of possible language to the regulations regarding COTA's. It was decided that if legislation is to go forward for licensure of COTA's, then legislation language was unnecessary.

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# **#5. 2008 COTA Legislation**

Alexander Macaulay, Virginia Occupational Therapy Association, discussed his letter to Dr. Harp regarding drafted legislation for licensure of occupational therapy assistants. After discussion of the letter, Mr. Macaulay requested the Advisory Board's input and recommendations on the drafted legislation. Although not in "final" form, he believes that the Advisory Board's review of the draft would be helpful. Ms. Hearst moved to have VOTA redraft the regulations and submit to the Advisory Board for feedback in November.

# #6. Summary of 2007 General Assembly Actions

Ms. Yeatts presented and explained the Advisory Board report of the 2007 General Assembly.
