CALL TO ORDER

Board to review it earlier. Mr. Lessin asked Mr. Menefee to provide the workgroup with the average use of proceeds for bingo during the 2019 calendar year. In response, Mr. Menefee provided members with the following information:

Gaming Activity	Proceeds From Activity
Raffle Activity	49.2%
Bingo & Raffle Activities	9.2%
Bingo Activity	9%
All Activities	10.6%

Mr. Lessin asked for a motion to recommend to the Board to provide staff with the authority to do all that is necessary to file a Notice of Intended Regulatory Action (NOIRA) on behalf of the Board for the purposes of changing the use of proceeds on a bi-annual basis or at the discretion of the Board. The motion was made by The Honorable William Feasenmyer and seconded by Ms. Conrad. The motion passed by a unanimous vote.

With no further old business, Mr. Lessin moved onto new business.

NEW BUSINESS

With no new business from any of the members, Mr. Lessin moved onto public comment.

Mr. Lessin reminded members of the upcoming workgroup meeting on September 15, 2020, in Richmond.
