Ms. Nancy O'Brien, Chairman of the Housing Committee, reported on the morning joint meeting of the Housing Committee and the Community Development Committee. Ms. O'Brien summarized issues considered in a development of the draft annual Action Plan. The committee recommended adoption of a 2009 Action Plan presented to the Board. A motion was made, seconded and unanimously passed.

Ms. O'Brien reported that the Committee recommended an amendment to the 2008 annual Action Plan to reflect the Homeless

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Prevention and Rapid Re-housing Program funding provided in the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. A motion was made to amend the 2008 Action Plan. The motion was seconded and unanimously passed.

Codes and Standards Committee Mr. Anthony Clatterbuck, Chairman of the Codes and Standards Committee, reported the Committee met prior to the full Board meeting. The Committee approved a base document with code changes for the proposed Manufactured Home Safety Regulations, Industrialized Building Safety Regulations, Amusement Device Regulations, Virginia Certification Standards and the Statewide Fire Prevention Code. Work on the base documents and code changes will continue during the June 22, 2009 Committee meeting in Richmond. A full report of the Committee meetings and recommendations will be presented to the Board at the July 27, 2009 Board meeting.

VHDA Report

Ms. Susan Dewey, Executive Director of Virginia Housing Development Authority (VHDA) reported on the Low Income Housing Tax Credit Program, home ownership and foreclosure prevention.

Virginia Fire Services Board Report Mr. Michael Reilly reported on the recent meeting of the VFSB and provided an update on VFIRS, aide to localities, burned building training and mini grants. Mr. Reilly reported that the next Board meeting would be held on June 6, 2009 in conjunction with a ceremony to honor fallen fire fighters.
