Call to Order and Approval of Minutes

Mr. Anthony Clatterbuck, Chairman of the Codes and Standards Committee, called the meeting of the Committee to order. A motion was made to approve the Committee minutes of May 10, 2010. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Mr. Emory Rodgers, Deputy Directory of the Division of Building and Fire Regulation, reviewed each issue contained in the Codes and Standards Committee Work Book 5 that included (Tab 2) residential sprinkler related code changes, (Tab 3) code changes carried over from the May 10, 2010 meeting, (Tab 4) code changes considered as consensus and recommended for approval as submitted or modified, (Tab 5) code changes considered as consensus and recommended for disapproval, (Tab 6) code changes considered as non-consensus, and (Tab 7) proposals to implement legislation.

A motion was made to carry the proposed code change on 2009 IRC Section R313 (Townhouses) (page 8 of Book 5) over to the 2012 code change cycle to allow time for additional data to be collected. The motion was seconded and passed by roll call with Richard Evans, Thomas Fleury, Lori Fountain, Nancy O'Brien, Michael Reilly and Tip Strickland voting to affirm and Anthony Clatterbuck, Roger McLellon, Brian Mullins, Edwin Whitmore and Rick Witt voting in opposition.

A motion was made to approve the code change on C-310.6 (R313.1 - basement sprinkler option) (page 11 of Book 5). The motion was seconded and passed with a majority vote.
