Public Hearing

Mr. Clatterbuck opened a public hearing for the Board on the

proposed Manufactured Home Safety Regulations, the Virginia Certification Standards and the Standards Governing the Operation of Building Code Academies. There was no one present to speak on these regulations and the public hearing was closed. The public hearing was recorded by court reporter and will be available in a

separate document.

Report of the Codes and

Standards Committee

Mr. Clatterbuck provided a brief overview of the morning Codes and Standards Committee meeting and the joint meeting of the Board of Housing and Community Development and the Virginia

Fire Services Board The committee made recommendations on the

final building code and fire prevention regulations. Mr. John Ainslie made a motion to approve the recommendation of the committee for the Uniform Statewide Building Code, the Statewide Fire Prevention Code, the Industrialized Building Safety Regulations and the Virginia Amusement Device Regulations. The motion was seconded and unanimously passed.

Mr. Ainslie made a motion to adopt the committee recommendations for the Manufactured Home Safety Regulations, the Virginia Certification Standards and the Standards Governing the Operation of Building Code Academies, pending the completion of the public comment period on December 20, 2013. The motion was seconded and unanimously passed.

Amusement Device Technical Advisory Committee appointment There were two persons that were seeking an appointment to the vacant position on the Amusement Device Technical Advisory Committee that were present at the Board meeting, Mr. Steven M. Rothenberg of Rockville Maryland and Mr. Edward J. Seyller III of Arlington, Virginia. Both candidates spoke to the Board about their background and interest in serving on the committee. After discussion, the Board decided to select the Virginia resident, Mr. Seyller. A motion was made to appoint Mr. Seyller. The motion was seconded and unanimously passed.

VHDA Report

Ms. Susan Dewey, Executive Director of the Virginia Housing Development Authority, commented on the Governor's Housing Conference and reported that VHDA is not proposing any legislation for the 2014 General Assembly session.

VFSB Report

Mr. John Ainslie reported on the November 15 meeting of the VFSB. Mr. Ainslie reported on ATL, VFRIS, civilian and fire services deaths, and information from the Department of Forestry. Mr. Ainslie also reported on Virginia Public Safety Foundation funding for a memorial to First Responders. Mr. Robby Dawson reported on upcoming challenges related to training and certification standards.
