Council impressed with program. Steve Draper and Steve Witmer were asked to keep this line of communication open. Bring up at September meeting, seeking Council's endorsement of program.

Susan Rogers and Bob Sturm furnished a presented on "Cruising for a Cure" which benefits the leukemia and lymphoma society. Group rides to earn money to help in funding research for a cure.
