The meeting was called to order by Dr. Ingalls. With eight members of the Board participating, a quorum was established. A poll of those participating showed that a good faith effort to convene a regular meeting within the week was not possible.

Wayne Halbleib, Assistant Attorney General presented evidence that the continued nursing practice Christina Love, LPN 0002-090474 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Lindsay moved to summarily suspend the license of Christina Love pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for indefinite suspension of her license in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Wayne Halbleib, Assistant Attorney General presented evidence that the continued nursing practice Gary Sites, CMT 0019-010231 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Caliwagan moved to summarily suspend the massage therapy certificate of Gary Sites pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for revocation of his certification in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Wayne Halbleib, Assistant Attorney General presented evidence that the continued nursing practice Wesley Veney, CMT 0019-011480 may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Lindsay moved to summarily suspend the massage therapy certificate of Wesley Veney pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for revocation of his certification in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.
