Repeal regulations. Originally established under authority of §53.1-5 and §53.1-45.1 of the Code of Virginia, amendments by the 2003 Acts of the General Assembly (Chapter 94) divested the Board of Corrections (predecessor to the current Board) of authority to promulgate these regulations. Therefore, the Board no longer has the authority to promulgate regulations for public/private joint venture work programs operated in state correctional facilities and these regulations should be repealed.
