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10	The following words and terms, when used in this chapter, shall have the following meaning

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13	"Administrative Process Act" means Chapter 40 (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.) of Title 2.2 of the Code of
14	Virginia.
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16	"Agency" means any authority, instrumentality, officer, board, or other unit of state government
17	empowered by the basic laws to make regulations or decide cases "Board" means Board of
18	Accountancy.
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20	"Notification list" means the list used by the Board to notify persons or organizations pursuant to
21	this chapter. Such list may include electronic mailing lists or regular mailing lists maintained by
22	the Board.
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24 "Organization" means any one or more association, advisory council, committee, corporation, 25 partnership, governmental body, or other legal entity. 26 27 "Person" means one or more individuals. 28 29 18 VAC 5-10-20. Mailing Notification list. 30 31 The agency Board will shall maintain a list of persons and organizations who that will be mailed 32 the following documents as they become available: 33 34 1. "Notice of Intended Regulatory Action" to promulgate, amend, or repeal regulations. 35 2. "Notice of Comment Period" and public hearings-, and 36 3. Notice that the <u>a</u> final regulations have regulation has been adopted. 37 38 Failure of these persons and organizations to receive the documents for any reason shall not 39 affect the validity of any regulations otherwise properly adopted under the Administrative 40 Process Act, §9-6.14:7.1 of the Code of Virginia. 41 42 18 VAC 5-10-30. Placement on the mailing notification list; deletion. 43 44 Any person or organization wishing may request to be placed on the mailing notification list may 45 do so by indicating so electronically or in writing to the agency Board. In addition, the agency 46 Board, at its discretion, may add to the list any person, organization, or publication it believes

47	will serve the purpose of responsible enhancing participation in the formation or promulgation of
48	regulations regulatory process. Persons and organizations on the list will be provided all
49	information stated in 18 VAC 5-10-20. Individuals and organizations The Board may
50	periodically may be requested request persons and organizations on the list to indicate their
51	desire to continue to receive documents or <u>to</u> be deleted from the list. When mail is returned as
52	undeliverable over more than one day or there has been no response to a request from the Board,
53	individuals such persons and or organizations will be deleted from the list.
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55	18 VAC 5-10-40. Petition for rulemaking.
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57	Any person or organization may petition the agency Board to adopt a new regulation or amend
58	any an existing regulation. Any petition received shall appear on the Board's next agenda of the
59	agency. The petition shall state (i) the substance and purpose of the rulemaking that is requested
60	including reference to any applicable Virginia Administrative Code sections, and (ii) reference to
61	the legal authority of the Board to take the action requested. The agency Board shall consider
62	and respond to the petition within 180 days in accordance with § 2.2-4007 of the Code of
63	<u>Virginia</u> . The <u>agency</u> <u>Board</u> shall have sole authority to dispose of the petition.
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65	18 VAC 5-10-50. Notice of intent Intended Regulatory Action.
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67	Pursuant to § 2.2-4007 of the Code of Virginia, At at least 30 days prior to filing a proposed
68	regulation and the "Notice of Comment Period" and proposed regulations as required by §9-
69	6.14:7.1 of the Code of Virginia, the agency Board will shall publish a "Notice of Intended

Regulatory Action, or "NOIRA." This notice NOIRA will shall provide for at least a 30-day
comment period and shall state whether the agency Board intends to hold a public hearing. If the
Board does not intend to hold a public hearing, it shall state the reason in the NOIRA. The
agency Board is required to hold a hearing on the proposed regulation upon request by (i) the
Governor or (ii) 25 or more persons. Further, the notice NOIRA shall describe the subject matter
and intent of the planned regulation. Such notice NOIRA shall be transmitted to the Registrar of
Regulations for inclusion in The Virginia Register of Regulations.

18 VAC 5-10-60. Informational proceedings or public hearings for existing rules.

Within two years of the promulgation of a regulation In accordance with §§ 2.2-4007.1 and 2.2-4017 of the Code of Virginia, the agency Board shall periodically evaluate it its regulations for effectiveness and continued need. The agency Board shall conduct an informal proceeding, which may take the form of a public hearing, to receive public comment on existing regulation regulations. Notice of such proceedings shall be transmitted to the Registrar of Regulations for inclusion in The Virginia Register and shall be sent to the persons and organizations on the notification list identified in 18 VAC 5-10-30. Such proceedings may be held separately or in conjunction with other informational informal proceedings.

89 18 VAC 5-10-70. Notice of formulation and adoption.

91 At Prior to any meeting of the agency Board or a subcommittee where it is anticipated the 92 formation or adoption of a regulation will occur is anticipated, the subject matter shall be 93 transmitted to the Registrar of Regulations for inclusion in The Virginia Register. 94 95 If there are one or more changes with substantial impact on are made to a regulation from the 96 time that it is published as a proposed regulation to the time it is published as a final regulation, 97 any person may petition the agency Board within 30 days from the publication of the final 98 regulation to request an opportunity for oral or written submittals comments on the changes to 99 the regulations regulation. If the agency Board receives requests from at least 25 persons for an 100 opportunity to make oral or written comment, the agency Board shall (i) suspend the regulatory 101 process for 30 days to solicit additional public comment and (ii) file notice of the additional 30-102 day public comment period with the Registrar of Regulations, unless the agency Board 103 determines that the changes made are minor or inconsequential in their impact. 104 105 If the Governor finds that one or more changes with substantial impact have been made to 106 proposed regulation, he may suspend the regulatory process for 30 days to require the agency

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A draft of the agency's <u>Board's</u> summary description of public comment shall be sent by the agency <u>Board</u> to all public commenters on the proposed regulation at least five days before final adoption of the regulation.

<u>Board</u> to solicit further public comment on the changes to the regulation.
