Senate Bill 296 (2014 General Assembly) amends Code of Virginia § 46.2-1519 to allow the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board (MVDB) to administratively set most fees rather than by regulation. The new law is effective as of July 1, 2014 and therefore two out of three subsections that delineate fees in these regulations become obsolete as of July 1, 2014.

## Statement of final agency action

The 2014 General Assembly adopted an "Omnibus" MVDB bill. One of the features of this bill is to authorize the Board to set most fees within Code limits without the need to adopt regulations. The only fees that were not included in the legislation are the registration fees for motor vehicle dealer license plates. The Governor signed the bill (SB 296). Therefore as of July 1, 2014 two out of the three subsections that delineate fees in the "Motor Vehicle Dealer Fees" regulations are obsolete
