Subject: Statement of Legal Authority for proposed amendments to the Regulations Governing Pesticide

Applicator Certification under authority of Virginia Pesticide Control Act (2 VAC 20-51)

I have reviewed the Virginia Pesticide Control Board's proposed amendments to the Regulations Governing Pesticide Applicator Certification under authority of the Virginia Pesticide Control Act (2 VAC 20-51), to add new requirements for pesticide application and registered technicians. In my view, as counsel to the Virginia Pesticide Control Board, the Department and the Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services, the Board has the authority to promulgate the regulations, and amendments thereto, pursuant to §§ 3.1-249.30, 3.1-249.51, 3.1-249.52, 3.1-249.53, 3.1-249.54, 3.1-249.55, and 3.1-249.56 of the *Code of Virginia*.
