Subject: Letter of Assurance for Amended Regulations – Final Regulation on Virginia Voluntary Protection Programs (VPP) found at 16VAC25-200

I have reviewed the Department of Labor and Industry's proposed Final Regulation on Virginia Voluntary Protection Programs (VPP) found at 16VAC25-200 that was originally posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall on August 18, 2017, and reposted on November 15, 2017. In my view, as counsel to the Department of Labor and Industry, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to Title 40.1 of the Code of Virginia. The regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
