

BOARD FOR CONTRACTORS APPLICATION REVIEW MATRIX CRIMINAL HISTORY

Approved October 1, 2013

The following convictions will not be reviewed by the Board:

1. Felony convictions more than three years old with no subsequent reportable convictions, unless the conviction resulted in incarceration where the release date is less than one year from the application date. This does not include convictions involving murder, manslaughter, sexual assault, rape, robbery, indecent liberties, fraud, embezzlement, abduction, assaulting a police officer, resisting arrest, larceny, breaking and entering, burglary or contractor related convictions.
2. Misdemeanor convictions more than two years from the date of application.
3. Misdemeanor convictions for possession or distribution of a controlled substance with no other convictions.
4. Felony convictions for possession of controlled substance more than two years old with no other convictions. For convictions less than two years old if the applicant has completed a deterrence program.
5. Felony convictions of Title 46 of the *Code of Virginia* (Traffic Code).
6. Misdemeanor convictions for simple assault (except domestic assault and assaulting a police officer), disorderly conduct, and/or trespassing.
7. DUI convictions where the applicant has completed VASAP or another similar program accepted by the court or DMV after the latest conviction. This does not include felony convictions.
