



VOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: 01-020

ISSUED: March 1, 2005

<u>SUBJECT</u>: OSHA Support of NIOSH "FACE" Program

A. <u>Purpose</u>.

This directive transmits to field personnel guidelines for the cooperation of VOSH with OSHA in support of a National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) program called FACE: "Fatality Assessment and Control Evaluation".

This Program Directive is an internal guideline, not a statutory or regulatory rule, and is intended to provide instructions to VOSH personnel regarding internal operation of the Virginia Occupational Safety and Health Program and is solely for the benefit of the program. This document is not subject to the Virginia Register Act or the Administrative Process Act; it does not have general application and is not being enforced as having the force of law.

B. <u>Scope</u>.

This directive applies to all VOSH personnel.

E. <u>Action</u>.

Directors and Managers shall ensure that the guidelines in this Directive are followed.
