## GUIDANCE MEMORANDUM<sup>1</sup> No. 6-95Issue Date:April 21, 2008Subject:Biosolids Use Guidelines (issued 8/9/95, updated 10/1/01 & 04/21/08)

Legislation passed by the General Assembly (HB 2802, Acts of Assembly c. 881, 2007) and signed into law by the Governor, amended § 64.1-44.19:3 and § 32.1-164.2 through § 32.1-164.7 of the Code of Virginia providing for transferring the biosolids use permitting authority and the Biosolids Use Regulations from the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). The transfer became effective January 1, 2008.

The Division will implement the requirements of <u>§12VAC5-585</u> et seq. for the use of biosolids on permits issued under the Virginia Coal Surface Mining Reclamation Regulations (4VAC25-130-700.1 et seq.). The **Biosolids Use Guidelines** (http://www.dmme.virginia.gov/DMLR/docs/downloads.shtml) are to be used in conjunction with the aforementioned regulations.
